

# Mighty 11 Boys – 4 riders Mighty 11 Girls – 4 riders

This event will be select Teams to travel to Australia to represent NZ in the Mighty 11's Cultural Exchange and Australia vs. New Zealand - Mighty 11's Test.

The selection is open to all riders who will be 11 years old (actual age) on 1 June 2017.

All trialists must enter into their age group class

# RACE FORMAT - Mighty 11's:

All Riders: 4 qualifying motos. Each rider's 3 lowest moto points will be added, then;

8 or less riders: Points added to 5th (final) moto to determine top 4 placings.
9 - 24 riders: Top 8 riders to 1 final, points added to '3 best moto' points.
25 + riders: Top 16 riders race semi finals, points added to '3 best moto' points

Top 8 riders to final, points added to previous points.

Count back system to determine semi final and final positions. Semi

finals placing, last 'counted' moto placing, if necessary.

Finish position in Final will determine team selection if points tied.
