All entrants agree to be bound by the regulations and general conditions for this event as published by BMXNZ in it's latest rule book. Safety and safe practices at all BMXNZ calendared events are not negotiable and failure by anyone to comply by the code of conduct or rules of the sport will result in the removal of such person from the event facility.
