(amalgamations as required).

Classes will be determined after the close of entries for trophy allocation purposes.

RACING FORMAT

Challenge 20", Cruiser & Championship Classes:

4 motos for all classes, with deadman finals as required see below. In case of disruption or adverse weather, moto format may be changed or day allocation changed, at the discretion of the Chief Commissaire.

7 or less riders: 4 motos points aggregated

8 or 9 riders: 4 motos then; 7 riders to a deadman final

10-16 riders: to deadman final

17-32 riders: to deadman semis & deadman final

33-64 riders: to deadman quarters, deadman semis & deadman final to deadman eighths, deadman quarters, deadman semis &

deadman final

BMXNZ SUPERNATS Class:

4 random motos then with finals , part of the normal race order (not blocked raced)

All Prolines Compulsory male 15+ class

3rd Straight Prolines Compulsory female 15+ class Amateur lines only All other SUPERNATS Classes

Challenge & Championship licensed riders only.

(SUPERNATS is a novelty superclass)

7 or less riders: 5 motos points aggregated

8 or 9 riders: 4 motos then;

10-16 riders: to deadman final (no B final run)

17-32 riders: to deadman semis & deadman final + B Final

33-64 riders: to deadman quarters, deadman semis & deadman final + B final

Tied Positions:

All tied positions will be separated by Countback. No run-offs will be held.

This will be held approx. 30 minutes after the finish of racing – track side on each day, covering the classes that competed on that day.

Classes with 9 riders or more: Trophies to 3rd place and Race Plates to 8th place

Personalised certificates will be sent to clubs as soon as available.

SUPERNATS - Prize pool split evenly between male & female

Snr male/female \$625 each - Int male/female \$525 each - Jnr male/female \$325 each.

50% payback is kept in classes which riders entered.

Pay out to 11th place (1st, 2nd, 3rd in B final if run).

Mighty 11s Boys and Girls - Junior Test Team Selection Guidelines

BMX New Zealand National Championship - Friday 30 March 2018 New Plymouth Sharks BMX Club Facility, Castleton Park, Park Road, New Plymouth

Mighty 11 Boys – 4 riders Mighty 11 Girls – 4 riders

This event will be select Teams to travel to Australia to represent NZ in the Mighty 11's Cultural Exchange and Australia vs. New Zealand - Mighty 11's Test. The selection is open to all riders who will be 11 years old (actual age) on 1 June 2018. All trialists must enter into their age group class

RACE FORMAT - Mighty 11's:

All Riders: 4 qualifying motos. Each rider's 3 lowest moto points will be added, then:

8 or less riders: Points added to 5th (final) moto to determine top 4 placings. 9 - 24 riders: Top 8 riders to 1 final, points added to '3 best moto' points. Top 16 riders race semi finals, points added to '3 best moto' points 25 + riders:

Top 8 riders to final, points added to previous points.

Count back system to determine semi final and final positions. Semi finals placing, last 'counted' moto placing, if necessary.

Finish position in Final will determine team selection if points tied.

Riders' select lanes for Semi finals and Finals

GATE: 8 Lane Gate.

POINTS: 1 - 2 - 3 - 4 - 5 - 6 - 7 - 8 BMXNZ Moto Mixing.

REGISTRATION: Friday 8.15—8.45 am.

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- 1. All riders must compete in the 2018 BMX New Zealand National Championships
- 2. Selected Riders and Guardians will be required to sign and comply with the BMX NZ Test Teams Contract. Contracts are to be signed on the day of selection. Copies of the M11 Test Team Contract are available upon request from the BMXNZ Administrator at admin@bmxnz.co.nz).
- 3. Riders must attend all arranged team training sessions as arranged by BMX NZ Team Management.
- 4. Riders must be available to travel to Australia during May & June 2018. During this period riders will be billeted or accommodated only as arranged by BMX NZ Team Management. (Late returns with family are possible by arrangement).
- 5. All riders must have current passports and entry rights into Australia, copies of which must be handed in at time of selection (please have copies of passport with you at the BMX NZ National Championships selection to hand over with the signed contract.
- 6. Riders selected will be required to pay to BMX NZ New Zealand dollars \$500.00 to assist with the costs.
- 7. All riders must abide by the rules and regulations as set by BMX NZ.
- 8. Any rider wanting to be eligible for selection for a BMX New Zealand Test Team must be permanently resident, in New Zealand for the all of the relevant BMX New Zealand racing season (as published in the annual racing calendar) and up to the date or dates of the events for which the rider wishes to be considered for selection. "Permanently Resident" means actually living in New Zealand, and intending to live here indefinitely.
