## ***Mighty 11s Boys and Girls - Junior Test Team Selection Guidelines***

Whangarei Pre-Norths - Sunday 24 September 2017

### **Mighty 11 Boys – 4 riders Mighty 11 Girls – 4 riders**

This event will be to select Teams to represent NZ in the

**Mighty 11's Cultural Exchange and Australia vs. New Zealand - Mighty 11's Test.**

The selection is open to **all riders** who will be 11 years old (actual age) on **20 October 2017**.

All trialists must enter into their age group class

### **RACE FORMAT - MIGHTY 11's:**

- Gender Split:** Separate Male & Female trial will be held  
**All Riders:** 4 qualifying motos. Each rider's 3 lowest moto points will be added, then;  
**8 or less riders:** Points added to 5th (final) moto to determine top 4 placings.  
**9 - 24 riders:** Top 8 riders to 1 final, points added to '3 best moto' points.  
**25 + riders:** Top 16 riders race semi finals, points added to '3 best moto' points  
Top 8 riders to final, points added to previous points.

BMX New Zealand moto mix for all qualifying motos. Semi finals will be seeded snake method per best 3 moto points. Lane draw selection (rule 1.026) will be utilised for semi finals and finals.

**ENTRY FEE:** \$35.00

**ENTRIES CLOSE:** Sunday 10 September 2017 - **NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED**

**REGISTRATION:** Sunday 24 September 9.00 – 10.00 am.

### **TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:**

1. All riders must compete at the 2017 BMX New Zealand North Island Titles meeting in classes as required by BMX NZ
2. Selected Riders and Guardians will be required to sign and comply with the BMX NZ Test Teams Contract. Contracts are to be signed on the day of selection. Copies of the M11s Test Team Contract are available upon request from the BMXNZ Administrator at admin@bmxnz.co.nz).
3. Riders must be available to attend all team training sessions as arranged by BMX NZ Team Management.
4. It is not mandatory for riders entering the trials to also enter their age class in 20" or Cruiser classes at the Pre-North's Meeting.
5. Information contained within this flyer supersedes all other information or flyers previously provided
6. All riders must abide by the rules and regulations as set by BMX NZ and the 2017 Test Team management
7. Any rider wanting to be eligible for selection for a BMX New Zealand Test Team must be permanently resident, in New Zealand for the all of the relevant BMX New Zealand racing season (as published in the annual racing calendar) and up to the date or dates of the events for which the rider wishes to be considered for selection. "Permanently Resident" means actually living in New Zealand, and intending to live here indefinitely.

### **SELECTED M11s RIDERS:**

Riders must be available to assemble in Whangarei, from 10.00 am on Wednesday 18 October 2017, for Team Practice and Promotional Events as scheduled.  
Note: The day may change if further commitments are required.

Riders selected for the Mighty 11 Test Teams will be required to pay to BMX NZ \$200.00 to assist with covering costs.

## BMXNZ EVENT HEALTH & SAFETY STATEMENT

All entrants agree to be bound by the regulations and general conditions for this event as published by BMXNZ in its latest rule book. Safety and safe practices at all BMXNZ calendared events are not negotiable and failure by anyone to comply by the code of conduct or rules of the sport will result in the removal of such person from the event facility.
