FIRST WINDOWS & DOORS is proud to present the 2018 BMX New Zealand Championship Nationals. This event will be held at the Christchurch City BMX Club track. The following guidelines will detail the event & requirement for entry.

EVENT LOCATION:

Venue - Christchurch City BMX Club
Address - Kyle Park, Waterloo Road, Hornby, Christchurch

ENTRIES CLOSE:

Sunday, 26 November 2017.
Online entries only. No late entries will be accepted.

ENTRY FEES:

All entries - \$110.00

ENTRY INFORMATION:

No entry will be taken on day of event.
Entry is complete only when payment is confirmed.
BMXNZ reserves the right to refuse entry to any person.
No refunds will be given after Friday 12 January 2018 for any reason. Refund prior to this will be given on receipt of medical certificate, less administration fee of \$20.

NUMBER PLATES:

Number plates will be issued by event organiser.

REGISTRATION:

Championship riders to self register at the following time ONLY.
4:00 - 5:00 pm - Friday 12 January
8:00 am - 8:30 am - Saturday 13 January
Plates & registration will NOT be accepted outside of these times

11.15 am

RIDER & MANAGERS MEETING:

9.30 am - Saturday

PRIZE GIVING:

Prize giving will commence onsite between the 3rd & 4th round of the main South Island Titles event, Saturday 13 January 2018

SEEDING:

Championship riders will be seeded into motos based on their overall UCI ranking.

MINIMUM CLASS SIZE

5 riders constitute a class.

RACING FORMAT & MOTO DRAW

UCI Transfer System
In case of disruption or adverse weather, moto format may be changed, at the discretion of the Chief Commissaire.

AWARDS & TROPHY ALLOCATION:

Trophies and Presentation Plates to 3rd place

CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS PURSE PAYMENTS:

Purse of \$2000.00 will be proportionally split between classes based on gender equity, number of entries and then pay out to 8th place.

SCRUTINEERING:

Officials can & will randomly check riders before and during the event, including all official practice and warm up sessions when all rule requirements apply and event number plates must be worn.

ONLINE ENTRY PROCESS:

Below is the **BMXNZ** link to the **INDIVIDUAL ONLINE ENTRY** site. All riders wishing to enter the event must **ENTER THEMSELVES**. Supply all detail as requested, check entry detail & confirm entry.

PAYMENT will follow the entry process, either via CREDIT CARD or POLi PAY on the site provided online.

LIVE RIDER LISTS will be shown online & update daily from the entry detail input by the entrants. Any corrections must be supplied to the entry admin prior to entry close. Changes after entry close will result in a \$50 change fee.

REGISTRATION at the event will **ONLY be at the times stated on the flyer**. Riders packs & plates are to be collected & signed for by the rider or a representative of the rider. The responsibility of the packs & plates are on those who collect them.

BMXNZ SOUTH ISLAND TITLES EVENT HEALTH & SAFETY STATEMENT

BMXNZ, The Mainland North Region & Christchurch City BMX Club will comply with the requirements of the Health and Safety in Employment Act 2015 by committing to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy environment for all riders, families and visitors to the BMX Event facility. It is the sports policy to “make every practical and reasonable effort to protect all visitors, to prevent accidents or serious harm injuries and promote safety and welfare of all persons while on the event facility”.

BMXNZ, The Mainland North Region & Christchurch City BMX Club will take all possible steps to list and evaluate hazards and to determine solutions to eliminate or minimise those hazards as part of the Risk Management Plan (RMP), to meet the sports policy noted above.

BMX Racing is an action sport & inherently has risks that are accepted as part of sport. All known risks are noted in the BMXNZ Major Meeting RMP & this is available onsite during the event. Parties wanting to assess the RMP prior to entry must contact the club for detail. Entry to this event confirms an understanding of the risks of the sport as noted in the RMP. In the event of injury to an event participant, a completed entry is consent to proper medical treatment being administered. Event entry also consents to submit to drug testing if required. All entrants agree to be bound by the regulations and general conditions for this event as published by BMXNZ in its latest rule book. Any reference to BMXNZ within this flyer or entry is referring to BMX New Zealand Inc.

Safety and safe practices at all BMXNZ calendared events are not negotiable and failure by anyone to comply by the code of conduct or rules of the sport will result in the removal of such person from the event facility.
