Entry to this event confirms an understanding of the risks of the sport as noted in the RMP. In the event of injury to an event participant, a completed entry also consent to proper medical treatment being administered. Event entry also consents to submit to drug testing if required. All entrants agree to be bound by the regulations and general conditions for this event as published by BMXNZ in its latest rule book. Any reference to BMXNZ within this flyer or entry is referring to BMX New Zealand Inc.

Safety and safe practices at all BMXNZ calendared events are not negotiable and failure by anyone to comply by the code of conduct or rules of the sport will result in the removal of such person from the event facility.

TRANSPONDER INFORMATION

Activation & Registration

All transponders will need to be activated with MYLAPS (activation info supplied with transponder) & then registered with BMXNZ. The registration will be done through a link on https://bmx.cyclingnewzealand.nz/transponders

Bike Types & Transponders

BMXNZ will require each of your bikes being raced to have its own transponder. So if you ride 20" & Cruiser at the BMXNZ major events, each bike will need its own transponder.

SPROCKETS and Transponders

For the 2018 North Island Titles & the Pre-Norths Test event, riders UCI 5 & under will not be requiring transponders & will be a participation only class. UCI 6 & UCI 7 riders will need transponders for all Major Meetings for the 2018/2019 season. For the Pre-Norths Test event only transponders are optional for all Sprockets.
