Expert: 14-16 yrs: Points from per 20"age group motos count towards NRRS. (This allows these riders to enter the BMXNZ Super Tour or NH Super Class)

9 or less riders 3 motos, last placed rider will be dropped, remaining 8 transfer to 3 finals, points over the 3 finals.

4 Riders constitute a class. Female riders may move across to male classes.
