FIRST Windows & Doors is proud to present the 2020 BMX New Zealand National Championships, the premier event for BMX racing in New Zealand. The following guidelines will detail the event & requirements for entry.

EVENT LOCATION:

Venue - North Avon BMX Club Address - Bexley Park, 498 Pages Road, Bexley, Christchurch

ENTRIES CLOSE:

Sunday, 1 March 2020. Late entries will be accepted until Sunday 8th March 2020 for an additional fee

ENTRY FEES:

Challenge Class (20" and Cruisers) \$95.00 per Rider per Class Late Entry Challenge Class (20" and Cruisers) \$150.00 per Rider per Class Participation Classes (Sprockets 7yr & under) \$30.00 non-title event Championship Superclass \$30.00 non-title event

ENTRY INFORMATION:

All event classes via INDIVIDUAL ONLINE ENTRY ONLY

No entry will be taken on day of event.

Entry is complete only when payment is confirmed.

BMXNZ reserves the right to refuse entry to any person.

No refunds will be given after 8.30am Saturday 11 April 2020 for any reason. Refunds prior to this will only be given on receipt of medical certificate, less an administration fee of \$20.

TRANSPONDERS:

Transponders will be used in conjunction with a finish line camera system for all riders except Sprocket 7yr & under riders. Please update your Online Profile with your transponder number BEFORE the entries close - https://nzbmx.club/riderportal There will be NO rental transponders from BMXNZ

Transponder check & registration. All transponders are required to be checked /registered onsite prior to racing. This process will be done at the check point near the Admin hut and is a simple roll over a mat loop & then checking detail on a screen. Any errors must be noted with event admin. This process can be done at any time during the Friday & Saturday practice times.

It is the **rider's responsibility** to have the correct transponder fixed to their bike and ensure subscription is current. Riders failing to have a working transponder affixed will be deemed as did not finish (DNF). If a rider's transponder fails during a race, a best effort will be made to correctly place the rider. If not possible then the rider will receive last place. NUMBER PLATES:

Number plates will be issued by BMXNZ to the club/team managers ONLY.

Riders holding a valid 2019 World & NZ ranking of 1-8 ONLY may choose to enter the meeting using this ranking (no other ranking may be used). All other riders may allocate at entry a non-ranking 'personal' or 'club' number, all others outside these parameters will be allocated a random plate number.

MOTO DRAW & SEEDING:

BMXNZ random computer moto mixing & lane draws used for all challenge classes Quarter, Semi Finals - snake seeding method. Finals lane draws will be based off times of the last moto.

MINIMUM CLASS SIZE

All Classes **6 riders** constitute a class (amalgamations as required). Classes will be determined after the close of entries for trophy allocation purposes.

RACING FORMAT

Challenge 20", Cruiser & Championship Superclass:

4 motos Saturday, 2 motos Sunday then finals (depending on class sizes)

8 or less riders:4 motos Saturday, 3 motos Sunday, points aggregated9 or more riders:4 motos Saturday, 2 motos Sunday then;9-16 riders:to deadman final17-32 riders:to deadman semis & deadman final33-64 riders:to quarters, semis & final (all deadman)65-80 riders:to eighths, quarters, semis & final (all deadman)

Tied Positions:

All tied positions will be separated by Countback. No run-offs will be held.

PRIZE GIVING:

This will be held on Sunday after the finish of racing, at a location off site. TBC

AWARDS & TROPHY ALLOCATION:

Classes with 8 riders or less: Trophies and Race Plates to 3rd place Classes with 9 riders or more: Trophies to 3rd place and Race Plates to 8th place Personalised certificates will be sent to clubs as soon as available. Championship Superclass - Prize pool split gender pay parity. Payback is kept within the classes which riders entered.

BMXNZ NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS EVENT HEALTH & SAFETY STATEMENT

BMXNZ, The Mainland North Region & North Avon BMX Club will comply with the requirements of the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 by committing to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy environment for all riders, families and visitors to the BMX Event facility. It is the sports policy to "make every practical and reasonable effort to protect all visitors, to prevent accidents or serious harm injuries and promote safety and welfare of all persons while on the event facility".



BMXNZ, The Mainland North Region & North Avon BMX Club will take all possible steps to list and evaluate hazards and to determine solutions to eliminate or minimise those hazards as part of the Risk Management Plan (RMP), to meet the sports policy noted above.

BMX Racing is an action sport & inherently has risks that are accepted as part of sport. All known risks are noted in the BMXNZ Major Meeting RMP & this is available onsite during the event. Parties wanting to assess the RMP prior to entry must contact the club for detail. Entry to this event confirms an understanding of the risks of the sport as noted in the RMP. In the event of injury to an event participant, a completed entry is consent to proper medical treatment being administered. Event entry also consents to submit to drug testing if required. All entrants agree to be bound by the regulations and general conditions for this event as published by BMXNZ in its latest rule book. Any reference to BMXNZ within this flyer or entry is referring to BMX New Zealand Inc.

Safety and safe practices at all BMXNZ calendared events are not negotiable and failure by anyone to comply by the code of conduct or rules of the sport will result in the removal of such person from the event facility.

Entry to this event assumes your acceptance that filming of all riders will be broadcast on international platforms via onsite live streaming.

Mighty 11s Boys and Girls - Junior Test Team Selection Guidelines

BMX New Zealand National Championship - Friday 10 April 2020 North Avon BMX Club, Bexley Park, 498 Pages Road, Bexley, Christchurch

Mighty 11 Boys – 4 riders Mighty 11 Girls – 4 riders

This event will be select Teams to travel to Australia to represent NZ in the **Mighty 11's Cultural Exchange and Australia vs. New Zealand - Mighty 11's Test.** The selection is open to **all riders** who will be 11 years old (actual age) on **1 June 2020**. All trialists must enter into their age group class

RACE FORMAT - Mighty 11's:

- All Riders: 4 qualifying motos. Each rider's 3 lowest moto points will be added, then; 8 or less riders: Points added to 5th (final) moto to determine top 4 placings.
- 9 24 riders: Top 8 riders to 1 final, points added to '3 best moto' points.
- **25 + riders:** Top 16 riders race semi finals, points added to '3 best moto' points Top 8 riders to final, points added to previous points.

Count back system to determine semi final and final positions. Semi finals placing, last 'counted' moto placing, if necessary. Finish position in Final will determine team selection if points tied. Riders select lanes for Semi finals and Finals

- **POINTS:** 1-2-3-4-5-6-7-8 BMXNZ Moto Mixing.

ENTRY FEE: \$35.00

ENTRIES CLOSE: 1 March 2020 - NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. All riders must compete in the 2020 BMX New Zealand National Championships

2. Selected Riders and Guardians will be required to sign and comply with the BMX NZ Test Teams Contract. Contracts are to be signed on the day of selection. Copies of the M11 Test Team Contract are available upon request from the BMXNZ Administrator at admin@bmxnz.co.nz).

3. Riders must attend all arranged team training sessions as arranged by BMX NZ Team Management.

4. Riders must be available to travel to Australia – during May & June 2020. During this period riders will be billeted or accommodated only as arranged by BMX NZ Team Management. (Late returns with family are possible by arrangement).

5. All riders must have current passports and entry rights into Australia, copies of which must be handed in at time of selection (please have copies of passport with you at the BMX NZ National Championships selection to hand over with the signed contract.

6. Riders selected will be required to pay to BMX NZ - New Zealand dollars \$500.00 to assist with the costs.

7. All riders must abide by the rules and regulations as set by BMX NZ.

8. Any rider wanting to be eligible for selection for a BMX New Zealand Test Team must be permanently resident, in New Zealand for the all of the relevant BMX New Zealand racing season (as published in the annual racing calendar) and up to the date or dates of the events for which the rider wishes to be considered for selection . "Permanently Resident" means actually living in New Zealand, and intending to live here indefinitely.
