24-25 October 2020 - Event Guidelines

FIRST Windows & Doors is proud to present the 2020 BMX New Zealand National Championships, the premier event for BMX racing in New Zealand. The following guidelines will detail the event & requirements for entry.

EVENT LOCATION:

Venue - North Avon BMX Club

Address - Bexley Park, 498 Pages Road, Bexley, Christchurch

ENTRIES:

NQM Dispensation Window - 1st-31st July

NEW Entries Open - 24th August

Entries CLOSE - 13th September

NO Late entries will be accepted

ENTRY FEES:

Challenge Class (20" and Cruisers) \$95.00 per Rider per Class

Participation Classes (Sprockets 7yr & under) \$30.00 non-title event

Championship Superclass \$30.00 non-title event

ENTRY INFORMATION:

All event classes via **INDIVIDUAL ONLINE ENTRY ONLY**

No entry will be taken on day of event.

Entry is complete only when payment is confirmed.

BMXNZ reserves the right to refuse entry to any person.

No refunds will be given after 8.30am Saturday 24 October 2020 for any reason. Refunds prior to this will only be given on receipt of medical certificate, less an administration fee of \$20.

REGISTRATION:

Club Team managers only to collect riders packs:

Friday 23 October 9:30 am to 10.30 am

Saturday 24 October 7.30 am to 8.30 am

TRANSPONDERS:

Transponders will be used in conjunction with a finish line camera system for all riders except Sprocket 7yr & under riders. Please update your Online Profile with your transponder number BEFORE the entries close - <https://nzbmz.club/riderportal>

There will be NO rental transponders from BMXNZ

Transponder check & registration. All transponders are required to be checked /registered onsite prior to racing. This process will be done at the check point near the Admin hut and is a simple roll over a mat loop & then checking detail on a screen. Any errors must be noted with event admin. This process can be done at any time during the Friday & Saturday practice times.

It is the **rider's responsibility** to have the correct transponder fixed to their bike and ensure subscription is current. Riders failing to have a working transponder affixed will be deemed as did not finish (DNF). If a rider's transponder fails during a race, a best effort will be made to correctly place the rider. If not possible then the rider will receive last place.

NUMBER PLATES:

Number plates will be issued by BMXNZ to the club/team managers ONLY.

Riders holding a valid 2019 World & NZ ranking of 1-8 ONLY may choose to enter the meeting using this ranking (no other ranking may be used). All other riders may allocate at entry a non-ranking 'personal' or 'club' number, all others outside these parameters will be allocated a random plate number.

OFFICIAL OPENING CEREMONY :

Opening ceremony and speeches Saturday 10.20 am

MOTO DRAW & SEEDING:

BMXNZ random computer moto mixing & lane draws used for all challenge classes
Quarter, Semi Finals - snake seeding method. Finals lane draws will be based off times of the last moto.

MINIMUM CLASS SIZE

All Classes **6 riders** constitute a class
(amalgamations as required).

Classes will be determined after the close of entries for trophy allocation purposes.

RACING FORMAT

Challenge 20", Cruiser & Championship Superclass:

4 motos Saturday, 2 motos Sunday then finals (depending on class sizes)

8 or less riders: 4 motos Saturday, 3 motos Sunday, points aggregated

9 or more riders: 4 motos Saturday, 2 motos Sunday then;

9-16 riders: to deadman final

17-32 riders: to deadman semis & deadman final

33-64 riders: to quarters, semis & final (all deadman)

65-80 riders: to eighths, quarters, semis & final (all deadman)

Tied Positions:

All tied positions will be separated by Countback. No run-offs will be held.

CLASSES OFFERED AT THIS EVENT:

20" – Challenge Classes:

****NOTE** - riders aged 7 that turn 8 at any time in 2020, must ride the UCI 8yr age class**

Female: 8-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16, 17-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50plus

20" – Championship Superclass:

Men's & Women's Elite & Men's & Women's Juniors

These classes are non-title events

PRIZE GIVING:

This will be held on Sunday after the finish of racing, at a location off site.

AWARDS & TROPHY ALLOCATION:

Classes with 8 riders or less: Trophies and Race Plates to 3rd place

Classes with 9 riders or more: Trophies to 3rd place and Race Plates to 8th place

Personalised certificates will be sent to clubs as soon as available.

Championship Superclass - \$1000 Prize pool split gender pay parity. Payback is kept within the classes which riders entered.

Regions Trophy – Region with the most Top 8 Plates

SCRUTINEERING:

Officials will randomly check riders before and during the event, including all official practice and warm up sessions when safety gear and number plates must be worn. It is recommended that clubs & managers scrutineer all bikes prior to the event.

Parking

Parking will be managed due to limited space available. Please listen & follow all instructions given by the host parking coordinators.

During this event the North Avon BMX Facility is a Smoke & Alcohol Free venue.

ALL team pit & food areas, track area & surrounds are to be smoke & alcohol free at ALL times. This excludes the main carpark.

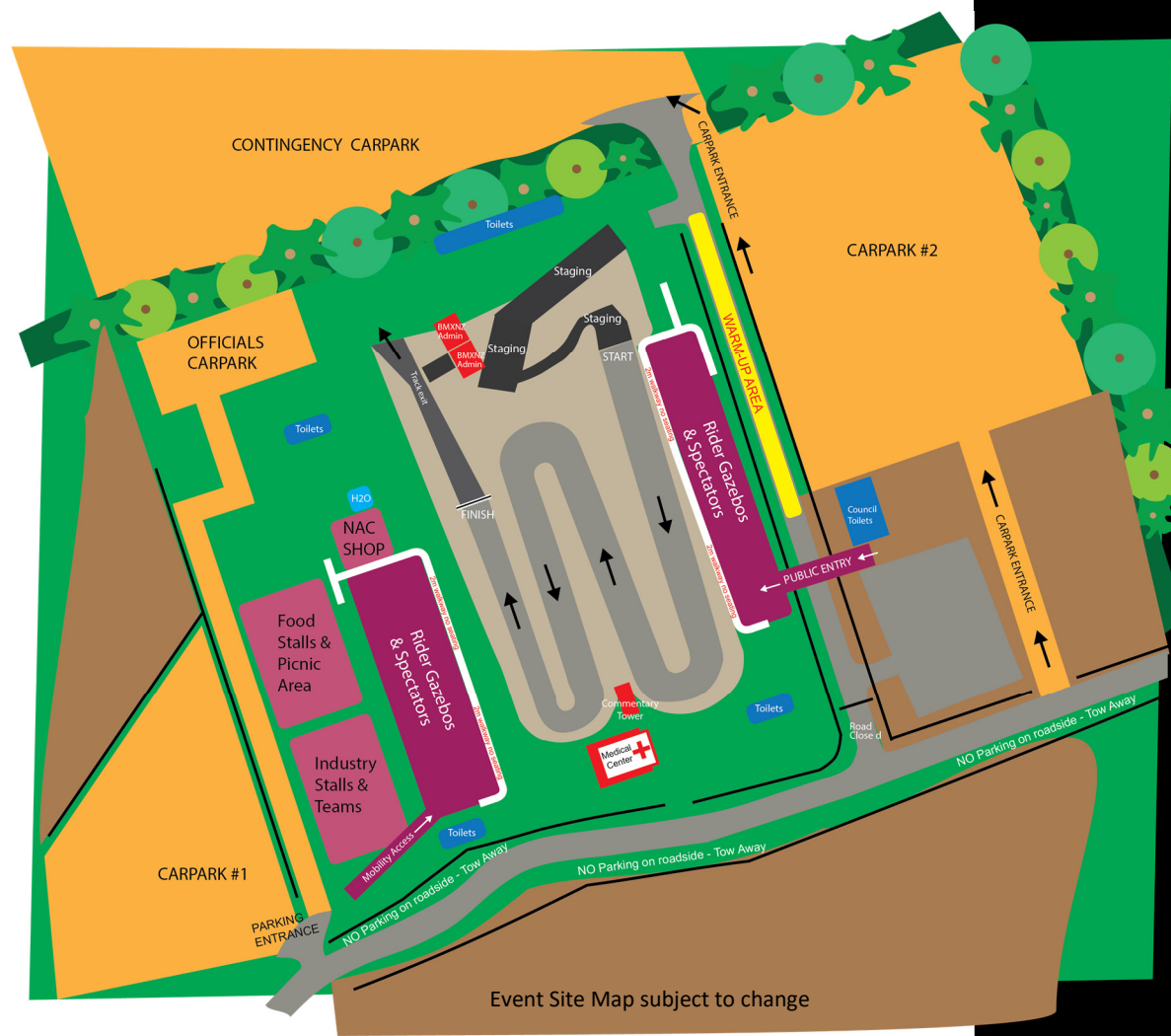

BMXNZ NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS EVENT HEALTH & SAFETY STATEMENT

BMXNZ, The Mainland North Region & North Avon BMX Club will comply with the requirements of the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 by committing to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy environment for all riders, families and visitors to the BMX Event facility. In the event of injury to an event participant, a completed entry is consent to proper medical treatment being administered. Event entry also consents to submit to drug testing if required. All entrants agree to be bound by the regulations and general conditions for this event as published by BMXNZ in its latest rule book. Any reference to BMXNZ within this flyer or entry is referring to BMX New Zealand Inc.

Safety and safe practices at all BMXNZ calendared events are not negotiable and failure by anyone to comply by the code of conduct or rules of the sport will result in the removal of such person from the event facility.
