SUPERTOUR GUIDE

SERIES PARAMETERS: All events for 15+ male or 13+ Female only

All events will be 4 moto, 1 final format

10 or more riders 4 Motos, then riders allocated to A and B Finals in a standard race format. Payout as per purse rule below

9 or less riders 4 Motos Last placed rider will be dropped,

remaining (8 or less) will transfer to the main final.

TOUR ROUNDS: Best 5 of 6 rounds will determine the overall TOUR winner

in each class.

LICENCE: UCI15+ Male & UCI13+ Female - Championship/Challenge

licences.

No younger riders riding up age groups Riders must hold a current race licence.

CLASSES OFFERED: Female 13+ (Challenge Straights)

Male EXPERT 15+ (Challenge Straights)

Male PRO 15+ (All Champ lic. & any Challenge lic.) (All Pro

straights compulsory)

Female riders 15+ may move across to Male Classes

Male riders may ride Pro or Expert Classes

ENTRIES & FEE: \$30 entry per event with \$25.00 payback. \$5 to the club.

REGISTRATION: Enter on the day . Payment is always cash on day.

LANE DRAW: Random lane selection per race system for Motos.

Finals lane picks based on ranking from motos.

MIN CLASS SIZE: 4 riders constitute a class.

TIEBREAKER: Tied results will be decided by countback.

PRIZE PURSE: There will be a rider proportional purse to be presented at each

event. Purse to be spread across A & B finals if needed.

No trophies or presentation plates.

Event Commissaries have jurisdiction to alter any of these regulations in the interests of rider Health and Safety, fair racing and payback.

BMXNZ EVENT HEALTH & SAFETY

BMXNZ, The Regions & BMX Clubs involved will comply with the requirements of the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 by committing to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy environment for all riders, families and visitors to the BMX Event facility. It is the sports policy to "make every practical and reasonable effort to protect all visitors, to prevent accidents or serious harm injuries and promote safety and welfare of all persons while on the event facility".

BMXNZ, The Regions & BMX Clubs involved will take all possible steps to list and evaluate hazards and to determine solutions to eliminate or minimise those hazards as part of the Risk Management Plan (RMP), to meet the sports policy noted above.

BMX Racing is an action sport & inherently has risks that are accepted as part of sport. All known risks are noted in the BMXNZ Meeting RMP & this is available onsite during any event. Parties wanting to assess the RMP prior to entry must contact the club for detail. Entry to this event confirms an understanding of the risks of the sport as noted in the RMP. In the event of injury to an event participant, a completed entry is consent to proper medical treatment being administered. Event entry also consents to submit to drug testing if required. All entrants agree to be bound by the regulations and general conditions for this event as published by BMXNZ in its latest rule book. Any reference to BMXNZ within this flyer or entry is referring to BMX New Zealand Inc.

Safety and safe practices at all BMXNZ calendared events are not negotiable and failure by anyone to comply by the code of conduct or rules of the sport will result in the removal of such person from the event facility.
