### Super 11s Boys and Girls - Interisland Test Teams Selection & Test Guidelines

BMX New Zealand North Island Titles TEST EVENT 5-6 December 2020

Te Awamutu BMX Club, Castleton Park, Park Road, Te Awamutu

Super 11 Boys – 8 riders Super 11 Girls – 8 riders

(4 vs 4 in each gender)

This NEW event will be to select two teams one from the South & one from the North to travel to the North Island Titles Event to represent their Island in the

Inter-Island South vs. North - Super 11's Test.

Selection to the teams is open to **all riders** who would have been 11 years old (actual age) on the two M11 trials for 2020 **1 June 2020** or **1st October 2020** 

All trialists must enter into their age group class

#### TRIAL FORMAT - One trial per Island:

All Riders: 4 qualifying motos. Each rider's 3 lowest moto points will be added, then;

**8 or less riders:** Points added to 5th (final) moto to determine top 4 placings. **9 - 24 riders:** Top 8 riders to 1 final, points added to '3 best moto' points.

25 + riders: Top 16 riders race semi finals, points added to '3 best moto' points

Top 8 riders to final, points added to previous points.

Count back system to determine semi final and final positions. Semi

finals placing, last 'counted' moto placing, if necessary.

Finish position in Final will determine team selection if points tied.

Riders select lanes for Semi finals and Finals

**POINTS:** 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8 BMXNZ Moto Mixing.

#### **TEST FORMAT:**

**Saturday:** 3 motos, beginning of rounds 2, 3, 4

**Sunday:** 2 motos, beginning of round 5 and end of round 6

**Points:** 10, 8, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1

(All points added. Team gate allocation as per M11s)

#### **BMXNZ EVENT HEALTH & SAFETY STATEMENT**

In the event of injury to an event participant, a completed entry is consent to proper medical treatment being administered. Event entry also consents to submit to drug testing if required. All entrants agree to be bound by the regulations and general conditions for this event as published by BMXNZ in its latest rule book. Any reference to BMXNZ within this flyer or entry is referring to BMX New Zealand Inc.

Safety and safe practices at all BMXNZ calendared events are not negotiable and failure by anyone to comply by the code of conduct or rules of the sport will result in the removal of such person from the event facility.
