Mighty 11s Boys and Girls - Junior Test Team Selection Guidelines

BMX New Zealand National Championship - Friday 12 March 2021
Rotorua Club, Waipa State Mill Road, Rotorua

Mighty 11 Boys – 4 riders
Mighty 11 Girls – 4 riders

This event will be to select Teams to travel to Australia to represent NZ in the **Mighty 11's Cultural Exchange and Australia vs. New Zealand - Mighty 11's Test**. The selection is open to **all riders** who will be 11 years old (actual age) on **1 June 2021**. All trialists must enter into their age group class for Nationals (riders not entered into Nationals must contact BMXNZ)

RACE FORMAT - MIGHTY 11's:

- Gender Split:** Separate Male & Female trial will be held
All Riders: 4 qualifying motos. Each rider's 3 lowest moto points will be added, then;
8 or less riders: Points added to 5th (final) moto to determine top 4 placings.
9 - 16 riders: Top 8 riders to 1 final, points added to '3 best moto' points.
17 + riders: Top 16 riders race semi finals, points added to '3 best moto' points
Top 8 riders to final, points added to previous points.

*Count back system to determine semi final and final positions. Semi finals placing, last 'counted' moto placing, if necessary.
Finish position in Final will determine team selection if points tied.
Riders select lanes for Semi finals and Finals*

GATE: 8 Lane Gate.

POINTS: 1 – 2 – 3 – 4 – 5 – 6 – 7 – 8 BMXNZ Moto Mixing.

REGISTRATION: Friday 1.00—2.00 am.

ENTRY FEE: \$35.00

ENTRIES CLOSE: 21 FEBRUARY 2021 - NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. All riders must compete in the 2021 BMX New Zealand National Championships
2. Selected Riders and Guardians will be required to sign and comply with the BMX NZ Test Teams Contract. Contracts are to be signed on the day of selection. Copies of the M11 Test Team Contract are available upon request from the BMXNZ Administrator at admin@bmxnz.co.nz).
3. Riders must attend all arranged team training sessions as arranged by BMX NZ Team Management.
4. Riders must be available to travel to Australia – dates to be determined late 2021. During this period riders will be billeted or accommodated only as arranged by BMX NZ Team Management. (Late returns with family are possible by prior arrangement). Test dates will be in conjunction with Cycling AUS and is dependant on an unrestricted travel bubble between NZ and AUS. Scheduled date will also be reliant on Cycling AUS confirming a suitable event. Should for any reason the Test event not proceed, the Trial entry is not refundable.
5. All riders must have current passports and entry rights into Australia, copies of which must be handed in at time of selection (please have copies of passport with you at the BMX NZ National Championships selection to hand over with the signed contract.
6. Riders selected will be required to pay to BMX NZ - New Zealand dollars \$500.00 to assist with the costs. This value will not be required until the Test dates are set and confirmed.
7. All riders and Parents must abide by both the rules and regulations and the codes of conduct as set by BMXNZ.
8. Any rider wanting to be eligible for selection for a BMX New Zealand Test Team must be permanently resident, in New Zealand for the all of the relevant BMX New Zealand racing season (as published in the annual racing calendar) and up to the date or dates of the events for which the rider wishes to be considered for selection. "Permanently Resident" means actually living in New Zealand, and intending to live here indefinitely.
