<u>Classes</u>

Intermediate (11-12yrs) - Riders MUST be UCI 11 to enter this event – no riding up. Riders must double class to be eligible to enter.

Intermediate (13-14yrs) - Riders MUST be UCI 13 to enter this event – no riding up. Riders must double class to be eligible to enter.

Series Final Purse

Waikato Region Superclass Series (WRSCS) has a \$200 Series Final Purse, split proportionally across all classes.

2022 Waikato Region Super Class Series Rules

Points will be allocated on the finishing position within each round on the following basis. Riders will get **5 bonus points** for attending and completing each of the rounds.

Please note a completed round is a rider that completes the final, whether that be **Main or B final**. If a rider has been dropped from 9 or less riders, that rider will get last place plus 3 points.

Overall final of the series will be held at the last region race meeting of 2022, dependent of 2022 Race calendar. At the end of the series, points will be calculated for each rider that have completed 3 rounds plus the final.

The top 8 from each age group will be decided from each rider's best 3 rounds and the final within each class.

Equal placings: In all cases a count back to the highest finishing position in the last race will be used.

Commissaries: have jurisdiction to alter these rules in the interests of Health and Safety, fair racing and payback.

The format or the ability to deliver this event could be subject to COVID Health regulations during the lead into the event or at the time of the event. Please be aware that both delivery or event format may change at any time. Waikato Region & host club will endeavour to advise the sport as soon as possible if changes are made.
