Selection Guidelines

Pre-Norths Event - Sunday 7 November 2021
New Plymouth BMX Club, Hickford Park, St Andrews Drive, Bell Block

SUPER11 Boys – 8 riders

SUPER11 Girls – 8 riders

This event will be to select Teams to compete in a SUPER11s event at the 2021 BMX New Zealand North Island Titles held at the New Plymouth BMX Club.

The selection is open to all riders who will be 11 years old (actual age) on 1 October 2021.

MIGHTY11s Titular Selection

The top FOUR boy & girls, will be afforded the titular title of a 2021 MIGHTY 11s selection. These names will be added to the M11s trophies along with the Australian team that has been selected for the canceled M11 Trans-Tasman event.

Please note this is ONE trial for both the S11 and M11 Teams

RACE FORMAT - SUPER11's:

Gender Split: Separate Male & Female trial will be held

All Riders: 4 motos. Rider's 3 lowest moto points will be added, then;

8 or less riders: Points added to 5th moto to determine top 8 placings.

9 - 16 riders: Top 8 riders to 1 final, points added to moto points.

17 + riders: Top 16 riders race semi finals, points added to moto points. Top 8 riders to a final, points added to all previous points.

- Count back system to determine semi final and final positions. Semi finals placing, last 'counted' moto placing, if necessary.

- Finish position after the Final will determine snake seeding team selection for SUPER11s Team allocation.

- Riders select lanes for Semi finals and Finals

GATE: 8 Lane Gate.

POINTS: 1 – 2 – 3 – 4 – 5 – 6 – 7 – 8 BMXNZ Moto Mixing.

REGISTRATION: Sunday morning of the event at race admin.

ENTRY FEE: \$35.00

ENTRIES CLOSE: 17 October 2021 - NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. Riders must also enter their age group at Pre-Nats, all riders must also compete in the M11s Memorial Class at the 2021 BMX New Zealand North Island Titles Event.
2. Selected Riders and Guardians will be required to sign and comply with the BMX NZ Test Teams Contract. Contracts are to be signed on the day of selection. Copies of the S11 Test Team Contract are available upon request from the BMXNZ Administrator at admin@bmxnz.co.nz
3. Riders must attend all arranged team training sessions as arranged by each Team Management.
4. Travel allowances are as per the Mighty 11s Trial and Test. South island rider are allotted two travel allowances for the trial (one male, one female). All south Island riders selected for the S11 Teams will be allotted a travel allowance for the North Island Titles event.
5. All riders and Parents must abide by both the rules and regulations and the codes of conduct as set by BMXNZ.
8. Any rider wanting to be eligible for selection for a BMX New Zealand Test Team must be permanently resident, in New Zealand for the all of the relevant BMX New Zealand racing season (as published in the annual racing calendar) and up to the date or dates of the events for which the rider wishes to be considered for selection . "Permanently Resident" means the rider/s actually living full time in New Zealand, and intending to live here indefinitely.

BMXNZ EVENT HEALTH & SAFETY STATEMENT

In the event of injury to an event participant, a completed entry is consent to proper medical treatment being administered. Event entry also consents to submit to drug testing if required. All entrants agree to be bound by the regulations and general conditions for this event as published by BMXNZ in its latest rule book. Any reference to BMXNZ within this flyer or entry is referring to BMX New Zealand Inc.

Safety and safe practices at all BMXNZ calendared events are not negotiable and failure by anyone to comply by the code of conduct or rules of the sport will result in the removal of such person from the event facility.
