Mighty 11s Boys and Girls Junior Test Team Selection Guidelines

Mountain Raiders - Sunday 28 September 2025

Lloyd Elmore Park, Bells Road, Pakuranga Heights, Auckland

Mighty 11 Boys – 4 riders

Mighty 11 Girls – 4 riders

This trial event will be to select Teams to represent NZ in the **Mighty 11's Cultural Exchange and Australia vs. New Zealand - Mighty 11's Test**. The trial event is open to **all riders** who will be 11 years old (actual age) on the **31st of December 2025**.

RACE FORMAT - MIGHTY 11's:

Gender Split: Separate Male & Female trial will be held

All Riders: 4 qualifying motos. Each rider's 3 lowest moto points will be added, then;

8 or less riders: Points added to 5th (final) moto to determine top 4 placings.

9 - 16 riders: Top 8 riders to 1 final, points added to '3 best moto' points.

17 + riders: Top 16 riders race semifinals, points added to '3 best moto' points
Top 8 riders to final, points added to previous points.

BMX New Zealand moto mix for all qualifying motos. Semifinals will be seeded snake method per best 3 moto points. Lane draw selection (BMXNZ rule 1.026) will be utilised for semifinals and finals.

ENTRIES CLOSE: Sunday 14 September 2025 - **NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED**

REGISTRATION: Sunday 28 September 2025 9.00 – 10.00 am.

TRANSPONDERS: All riders must run transponders for this event

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. Selected riders must compete at the 2025 BMX New Zealand North Island Titles event in classes as required by BMXNZ Mighty 11 Team Management.
 2. Selected Riders and Guardians will be required to sign and **comply with the BMXNZ Test Teams Contract**. Contracts are to be signed on the day of selection. Copies of the M11s Test Team Contract are available upon request from the BMXNZ Administrator at admin@bmxnewzealand.co.nz.
 3. Riders must be available to attend all team training sessions as arranged by BMXNZ Team Management.
 4. It is not mandatory for riders entering the trials to also enter their age class in 20" or Cruiser classes at the Pre-North's Meeting.
 5. Information contained within this flyer supersedes all other information or flyers previously provided
 6. All riders in the trial must abide by the rules and regulations as set by BMXNZ and the Mighty 11s Team management
 7. Any rider wanting to be eligible for selection for a BMX New Zealand Test Team must permanently reside in New Zealand, for the all of the relevant BMX New Zealand racing season (as published in the annual racing calendar) and up to the date or dates of the events for which the rider wishes to be considered for selection. "Permanently Reside" means have to been living in New Zealand, and intending to live here indefinitely.
- SELECTED M11s RIDERS:**
- Riders must be available to assemble in Auckland, from 10.00am on Wednesday 22 October 2025, for Team Practice and Promotional Events as scheduled.
- Note: The day may change if further commitments are required.
- Riders selected for the Mighty 11 Test Teams will be required to pay to BMXNZ \$250.00 to assist with covering costs.

Open to New Zealand entrants only. Please read the Terms & Conditions carefully – these are outlined in this event flyer.

Payment:

Payment is required at the time of entry via Credit Card or PoliPay. Your entry will only be confirmed once payment has been successfully processed.

No late entries will be accepted for any reason.

Reimbursements:

- No refunds will be given after Friday 26 September 2025 for any reason.
- Refunds prior to this date will be given only on receipt of a medical certificate, less a \$20 administration fee.

Closing Date:

Entries close 14 September 2025 – online entries only.

Officials will explain what needs to be corrected and give you a reasonable chance to follow their instructions. If you choose not to comply after this, you may be removed from the event site.
